What will happen to the earth in the future? Scientists believe that over the next 10,000 million years earthquakes and volcanoes will get rarer. The earth will become flatter, with no high mountains and shallow oceans will cover most of the planet.

The sun will run short of the hydrogen if uses for fuel and become much larger than it is now. This will heat up the earth, evaporating water from the seas and the oceans will get dry. Eventually the sun will cool down, leaving the earth as a dead frozen planet.

Man might make our planet uninhabitable long before any of this happens. We may increase the carbon dioxide in the atmosphere so that it forms a barrier that traps heat in but doesn't let it out.
